✓ **Indication**  
Senior dogs, that require fewer calories, from 7 years old (i.e. dogs that are less active, neutered or otherwise prone to obesity).

✗ **Not recommended for:**

- Cats.
- Puppies.
- Pregnant or lactating bitches. During pregnancy and lactation bitches should be switched to **Science Plan Puppy** or **Science Plan Puppy Mini**.
